SERVIZI ITALIA: Roberto Olivi has been co-opted onto the Board of Directors to replace Augusto Torreggiani.

Luciano Facchini becomes Chairman pursuant to the Statute currently in force.

The Board of Directors of Servizi Italia S.p.A. – a company listed on the STAR division of the Electronic Stock Market (MTA) of Borsa Italiana S.p.A. – met today and co-opted Roberto Olivi into the role of Director, pursuant to article 2386 of the Italian Civil Code and to the Statute currently in force, to replace Augusto Torreggiani, who resigned on 5 March 2010.

The new member of the board Roberto Olivi, 48, from Reggio Emilia, has a degree in Economics and Business from the University of Modena. He has been with Coopservice since 1990, and is currently General Manager there. Olivi boasts significant management experience gained in leading positions of responsibility. Most recently, he headed the security division (14 security branches in the Centre-North of Italy, from Reggio Emilia to Rome, with a staff of over 1800), which has experienced constant growth in recent years under his management, making Coopservice one of the leading operators in Italy in the field of private security services.

Furthermore, pursuant to the Statute currently in force, the BoD entrusted the CEO Luciano Facchini with the office of Chairman, also appointing Director Enea Righi as Vice Chairman .
